To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- √ Be a resident of the State of Vermont.
- √ Have demonstrated academic excellence in high school with a high class rank (top 10 percent is suggested) and high academic achievement (1550 combined score or better is suggested) on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). Nontraditional or adult students who have never taken or not taken these tests recently should contact the Director of Admissions for special information.
- √ Complete the Vermont Tech Application for Admission (if you have not already done so) and return it to the Office of Admissions, Vermont Technical College, Randolph Center, VT 05061.
- √ Complete the Scholars Application and return it with two completed Vermont Tech Scholars recommendations to the Office of Financial Aid, Vermont Technical College, Randolph Center, VT 05061, by April 1. One recommendation should be from a teacher who can address your academic qualifications and the other should be from an individual (who is not related to you) who can attest to your personal attributes.
- √ Attach a type-written or computer-printed list and brief description of awards and honors you have received, and community service, employment or other significant activities in which you have been involved during (and after, if appropriate) your high school years.
- √ Attach a type-written or computer-printed essay of not more than 250 words in which you discuss an individual or event that has had a profound effect on you.
- √ Preference will be given to students who are attending college for the first time.

The VTC Scholars Committee will review the applications and select candidates and alternates by April 6. Candidates must notify the Directors of Admissions and Financial Aid of their acceptance of admission and the scholarship by May 1. Each scholarship recipient's academic record will be reviewed at the conclusion of each semester. The recipient must maintain a 3.0 cum GPA and continue to make a positive contribution to the college community in order to retain the scholarship for successive semesters. Applicants and recipients must comply with all admissions procedures and academic policies and procedures of Vermont Technical College.
