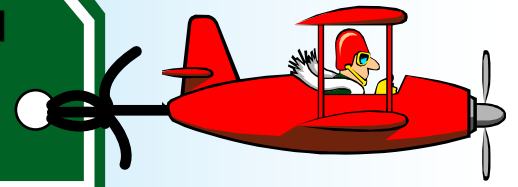

From boarding houses and poolrooms to stables and churches, the history of the schools that have existed in Randolph Center, Vermont flow through the buildings of the campus and community. When the Orange County Grammar School opened in 1806, the school and the community were completely intertwined. Later, when the RSNS classroom building was completely destroyed by fire in 1893, it was the community members that kept the school going -- holding classes in homes and churches until the new structure was built.
