IT'S FAFSA TIME!

Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The best method to complete your FAFSA is to use the FAFSA web site and complete the application online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. If you need assistance in completing the FAFSA, feel free to contact the financial aid office at 728-1448.

The VTC Federal School Code is 003698. When your FAFSA is processed by the federal government you will receive a paper or electronic copy of your student aid report. A follow up tracking letter from financial aid will be sent regarding any other supporting documentation. We do require signed copies of 2009 tax returns for both the student and for parents if a dependent student. Priority deadline to file the FAFSA is MARCH 1st.

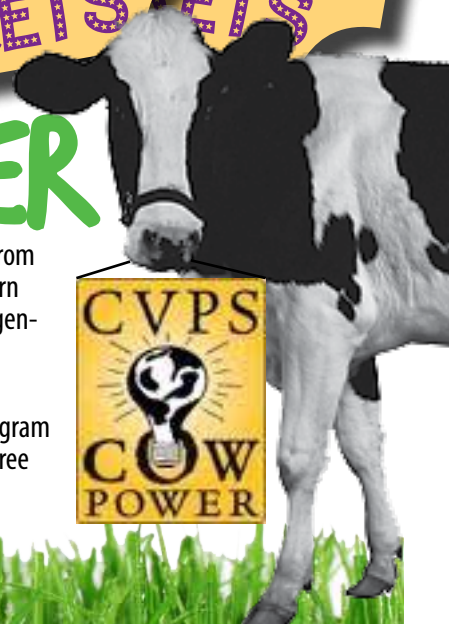
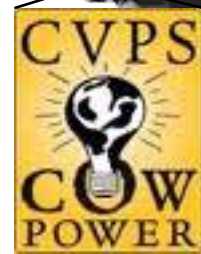
