The first year of the program focuses on the materials and methods of residential and commercial building construction. Students will learn about:

- Residential and Commercial Construction
- Drafting, print reading, CAD;
- Electrical and mechanical systems;
- Mathematics and Physics

During the summer after the first year, we assist students in obtaining an internship placement in the industry.

In the second year, students acquire the management skills needed for supervisory positions in the building industry. Skills such as:


- Construction project management;
