### STUDENT INFORMATION:

As an incoming Dental Hygiene student at Vermont Tech proper attire is required during observation in all dental settings. During observation please adhere to the following dress code:

- Hair should be away from face and shoulder and prevented from falling forward if leaning over
- Scrubs, dress slacks, or khakis. No jeans. No inappropriate exposure of body
- Lab coat, if possible
- No visible piercings or body art
- Closed toe shoes
